**BACKGROUND**

This scholarship in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded annually to a graduating senior at Magna Vista High School. It honors the memory of Frank J. Radnoczi, former counselor and coach at Magna Vista from 1988-1999.

During Frank's 26 years of service to the students of Henry County Public Schools, he served as a teacher, coach, and counselor at three high schools in the county. He taught physical education, history, and served as a high school counselor for the last 31 years of his career. The last 5 years were served in the Guidance Department at McMichael High School in Mayodan N.C. He coached baseball, basketball, football, and golf at Laural Park, Drewry Mason and Magna Vista High Schools. He was an Assistant Basketball Coach at Magna Vista when the 1998-99 MV boys basketball team won the Virginia State AA Championship. Frank's friendship, support, and guidance for the thousands of students whom he served will be a legacy to his successful career in education.

The funds for this scholarship are provided by a group of men who were friends and comrades of Frank, or "Squirrel" as they called him during his college days at Xavier University. These guys call themselves The Golden Grainers and have remained close since their graduation in the 1960's. Frank was a vital part of the group and continued to plan annual meetings and golf outings for the guys until his death in 2019. This group, now made up of successful professional men from all walks of life, are providing this scholarship out of their deep love and respect for Frank in hopes of encouraging young men and women to pursue careers in education. They urge prospective teachers, coaches, and counselors to use these funds to carry on Frank's memory in service to our youth.

1. A personal letter detailing why you should be considered for this scholarship. The letter should briefly outline why you have chosen education for your future career, any school and community activities, past awards, and future plans.
2. Two letters of recommendation
3. Transcripts of high school grades
4. A letter of acceptance to your intended school
